

## **Volunteer Role: Optometric Technician**

Purpose of the Role: As a volunteer optometric technician, you will be assisting doctors and opticians in the only Eye Clinic in the region that provides free eye exams and glasses for those in need.

What does the role involve?

- Handing out paperwork and compiling patient folders.
- Conducting pretesting (autorefractor, visual acuity test, tonometer) on patients before they see the doctor.
- Sanitizing equipment in-between patients.
- Coordinating with the doctor and optician to ensure that patients are seen in a timely and efficient manner.

Who would be suitable for this role?

No experience necessary, but someone with an interest or background in optometry is ideal. Excellent customer service skills and a passion for helping those in need is important. Must be comfortable in a fast-paced environment.

When?

Tuesdays from 8:30am-11:30am. Occasionally, the clinic closes late and requires volunteers to stay longer.
